The UN Secretary-General, in his 2010 message on the occasion of the Human Rights Day, said:

„It is primarily the responsibility of the governments of the States to ensure the protection of human rights advocates. I call on all States to respect freedom of expression and freedom of assembly, which are so necessary for their work. [...]. When the lives of human rights defenders are threatened, the sense of security of all people is reduced. When the voices of human rights defenders are ruined, justice suffers.”
